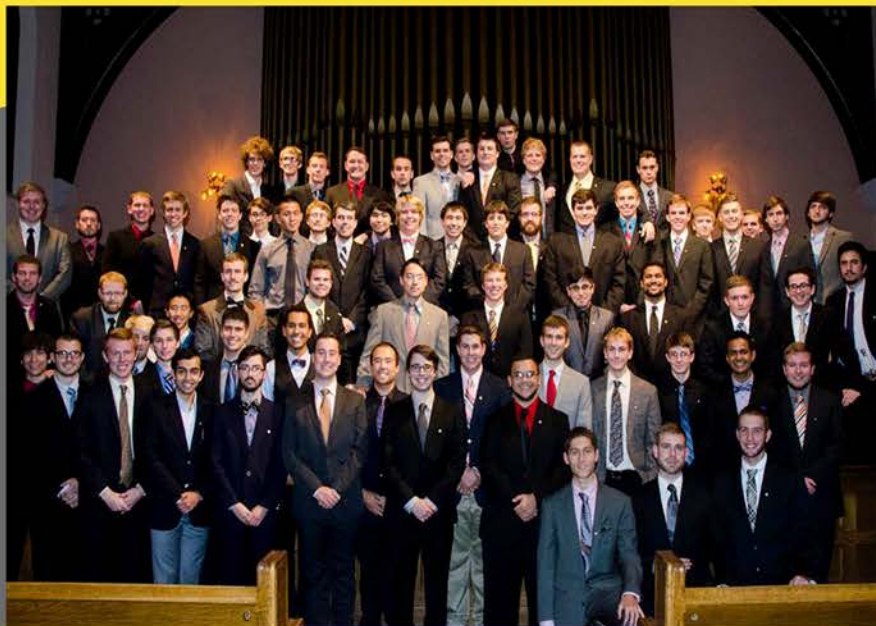
Brothers Stewart and Beckman were selected to serve on the Orientation Executive Board. They were responsible for all of the planning and logistics involved in First-Year Orientation.
